Doggy Popsicles

Doggy Popsicles is an easy and fast recipe to create a wonderful snack for your dog. It can be prepared in single or double quantities.

Ingredients

- 1 cup of your dog's favorite treat
- Ice cube tray
- 1 cup of water

Recipe

- Mix together your dog's favorite treat along with water.
- Fill extra large ice cube trays.
- Freeze until solid.
- You may serve when it turns solid.

This is not only a nice treat on a hot summer day, but it also keeps your dog hydrated.

Peanut Food Treat

Ingredients

- 2 cups of dry dog food
- 6 Broken or crumbled dog treats
- 2 Large scoops peanut butter

Recipe

- Arrange the dog food on the bottom of the baking dish.
- Stir in the dog treats.
- Spoon the peanut butter over the mixture and smooth out evenly.
- Cool in the refrigerator.

Doggy Biscuits

This is a good healthy snack that you can treat your dog anytime of the day.

Ingredients

- 5 cups Whole-wheat flour
- 1 tsp Salt
- 2 tsp Brown sugar
- 1 Egg, beaten
- 1 ½ cups Powdered dry milk
- ½ cup Meat juices or canned broth
- 1 Cup Ice water

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 350°
- Spray cookie sheet with “PAM”
- Combine flour, milk, salt, garlic powder and sugar.
- Cut in meat drippings and scrapings until mixture resembles corn meal.
- Mix in egg.
- Add enough water so that the mixture forms a ball.
- Roll out to ½ in thick.
- Use cookie cutters to cut out shapes.
- Bake 25-30 minutes.
- Remove from tray and cool on a rack.

You may serve it to him right now or store in an airtight container. It is recommended that you use it within 1 week.

Cheese and Garlic Biscuits

- 2 Cloves garlic, crushed
- 1 tsp of salt
- Milk (small amount of milk just to mix the other ingredients)



Recipe

- Grate the cheese in a food processor
- Let it sit out until it reaches room temperature.
- Combine the cheese, margarine, garlic salt and flour together.
- Mix small amounts of milk to the mixture until it forms a ball.
- Put in the fridge for 30 min.
- Roll to ¼ in thick and cut into shapes.
- Bake at 375° for 15 min or until slightly brown but firm to the touch.

Margarine Biscuit Recipe

Ingredients

- 5 Cups Whole-wheat flour
- 1 Cup Non-fat powdered dry milk
- 2 tsp Sugar
- 12 TBSP Butter or margarine
- 2 Eggs
- 1 Cup Cold water

Recipe

- Mix the first 5 ingredients with water.
- Knead in a food processor for 3 minutes until dough forms a ball. Roll out to ½ inch thick and cut into shapes.
- Bake on a greased flat pan for 30 mins at 350°.
- These can also be flavored with chicken or beef broth
- Cool completely for 30 mins.

Yogurt Pops

These are very tasty and healthy snacks that your dog would love to have anytime.

Ingredients

- 1 large container of yogurt
- 2 or 3 Bananas
- $\frac{3}{4}$ Cups of Water

Recipe

- Take yogurt, bananas and water and mix well in a food processor.
- Pour into molds and freeze.

- 1 Cup Powdered milk
- 2 Eggs, well beaten
- 5 Cups Flour
- 1 tsp Garlic salt
- 3 tsp Brown sugar
- 1 Cup Water
- ¼ Cup Gravy
- 1 jar of meat flavored baby food

Recipe

- Combine all ingredients and mix well.
- Roll and cut out shapes
- Bake at 350° for 25-30 minutes.
- Cool and Store in an airtight container.

Cheese Snacks

Cheese has nutritional value for dogs, this recipe will please any pup!!

Ingredients

- 4 Cups Whole-wheat flour
- ½ Cup Cornmeal
- 1 Cup Parmesan Cheese
- 2 Eggs
- 1 ½ Cups Water



Recipe

- Preheat oven to 325°.
- Combine all ingredients except Parmesan cheese.
- Knead until thoroughly combined.
- Roll dough into balls.
- On a floured surface, roll balls 'sticks' in Parmesan so the sticks are coated.
- Flatten and Twist each about 6 to 8 times and place on ungreased baking sheet.
- Bake approximately 30 minutes.
- Cool on pan.
- Serve or store in a sealed container.

- 4 Dog Bones
- 3 cups of peanut butter
- 2 cups dry dog food
- 12 TBSP corn syrup
- 4 crushed peppermints (makes breath smell fresh)

Recipe

- Combine peanut butter and corn syrup.
- Roll bone in peanut butter mixture and then in the puppy food and peppermints.
- Chill & serve.

Peanut Butter Biscuits with Bananas

As our children love peanut butter; puppies love it too. This recipe is great for a growing puppy!



Ingredients

- 2 Eggs
- 2/3 Cups Peanut Butter
- 1 Cup Mashed banana
- 2 TBSP Honey
- 1 Cup Wheat Germ
- 2 Cups Whole-wheat flour
- 2 Egg whites

Recipe

- In a bowl mix Egg, Peanut butter, Honey and Banana together till it is mixed well.
- Add dry ingredients a little at a time.
- Mix well and put on a well-floured counter or board.
- Roll to desired thickness and cut desired shape.
- Brush with egg whites.
- Preheat oven to 300° and cook for 20 then check for doneness.
- If not done cook for another 5-10 minutes.

Recipe

- Chop up your puppy's favorite Fruits small enough to put into ice cube trays.
- Fill tray with water and freeze until solid.

Banana Biscotti

If your puppy loves bananas then he will surely adore this yummy treat.

Ingredients

- 10 cups flour
- 1/2 cup peanuts, chopped
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup vegetable oil
- 3 cups banana, pureed
- 1 TBSP vanilla
- Water (as desired, just to mix it well)

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 325F.
- Mix all of the dry ingredients in large bowl. Make a well in the center.
- Add egg, oil and banana together. Combine with the dry ingredients in the center of the well.



- Start combining together.
- Add water, one teaspoon at a time as needed.
- Knead by hand on floured surface until mixed thoroughly.
- Roll into log
- Flatten log.
- Place on non-stick cookie sheets and Bake 30 - 40 minutes.
- Remove and cool for 10 minutes.
- Slice into appropriate sized slices.
- Place on baking sheets and bake for about 20 minutes or until golden brown.
- Let it cool.
- Store in airtight container.

Barley Beef Biscuits

This is a great snack for your non-veg dog.

Ingredients

- 1 cup extra virgin olive oil
- 2 tablespoons dried garlic
- ¼ cup parsley
- 4 cups beef broth
- 4 cups barley flour
- 6 cups rye flour

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 350 ° F
- In a large bowl, combine olive oil garlic and parsley.
- Heat the beef broth until hot, not boiling.
- Add to the olive oil mixture.
- Add the barley flour and let cool until lukewarm.
- Gradually blend in rye flour, adding enough to form a stiff dough.
- Use the rest of the rye flour to knead the dough until smooth. Shape the dough into a ball, and roll to ½-inch thick.
- Use a cookie cutter or cut into small squares.



- Put on an ungreased baking sheet, spacing them about 1/4 inch apart.
- Bake for 30 minutes.
- Remove from oven and turn over.
- Bake for an additional 30 minutes, or until golden brown on both sides.

Beefy Cookies

Puppies will love these yummy cookies.

Ingredients

- 4 6-ounce jars of beef-and-vegetable baby food
- 2 cups of wheat germ
- 4 cups of nonfat dry milk

Recipe

- Preheat your oven to 350F.
- Mix all ingredients in a large bowl with a mixer.
- Drop by teaspoon onto a greased pan.
- Flatten slightly.
- Bake for 12-15 minutes until slightly brown at the edges.
- Let it cool.
- Store in fridge for up to one week.

Big Boy Beef Biscuits

These are especially for larger sized dogs.

Ingredients

- 1 cup dries milk
- 2 eggs
- 4 teaspoons minced garlic
- 2-teaspoons parsley



- 12 tablespoons olive oil
- 4 teaspoons honey
- 1 large jar beef baby food
- 1 cup beef broth
- 1 cup rye flour
- 1 cup whole-wheat flour
- 1 cup rice flour
- 1 cup cracked wheat

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 325
- In a bowl, mix the dry milk, egg garlic, parsley, oil, honey, baby food, and broth.
- Gradually stir in the flours and cracked wheat.
- Add enough wheat flour to form stiff dough.
- Knead on a floured surface until smooth.
- Shape the dough into a ball, and roll to 1/2 thick.
- Use cookie cutters to make biscuits.
- Transfer to non greasy baking sheets, spacing them about 1/4 inches apart.
- Bake for 30 minutes.
- Flip over and Return to oven and bake for an additional 30 minutes.
- Let cool overnight.

Bone Abodanza

Bones are the first love of every dog. This recipe is sure to please your dog too!!!

Ingredients

- 1 lb. ground beef, uncooked
- 1/2 cup chicken broth
- 2/3 cups mashed black beans
- 2/3 cups cottage cheese
- 2 tsp. soy sauce



Recipe

- Combine all ingredients together and mix thoroughly.
- Mold the mixture into bone shapes and place on a cookie sheet. Bake for 45 minutes in a 375-degree oven.
- Let cool.

Biscuits

This recipe serves for anytime snacks.

Ingredients

- 4 teaspoons dry yeast
- 1 cup lukewarm water
- 4 tablespoons dry parsley
- 4 tablespoons minced garlic
- 1 1/2 cups chicken broth
- 6 tablespoons honey
- 2 eggs
- 10 cups whole-wheat flour

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 350
- Dissolve yeast in warm water.
- Mix in the parsley, garlic, broth, honey, and egg.
- Gradually blend in flour, adding enough to form stiff dough.
- Turn o to a floured surface and knead until smooth.
- Shape the dough into a ball, and roll to 1/4-inch thick.
- Using cookie cutters, make biscuits!
- Transfer to non greasy baking sheets, spacing them about 1/4 inch apart.
- Gather up the scraps, roll out again, and cut additional biscuits.
- Bake for 30 minutes.
- Remove from oven and turn over.
- Bake for an additional 15 minutes, or until lightly browned on both sides.
- Let cool overnight.

Chicken Cornmeal Treat

These are small treats with big taste.

Ingredients

- 2 cups rolled oats
- 2/3 cup butter
- 2 cups boiling water
- 1 1/2 cup cornmeal
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 2 teaspoons chicken or beef instant bullion
- 1 cup milk
- 8 ounces shredded cheddar cheese
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 4 cups white or wheat flour

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 325 degrees.
- Grease cookie sheets.
- In large bowl combine rolled oats, butter and water.
- Let stand for 10 minutes.
- Stir in cornmeal, sugar, bullion, milk, cheese and egg.
- Mix well.
- Add flour 1 cup at a time, mixing well after each addition to form stiff dough.
- On floured board knead in remaining flour until dough is smooth. Roll or pat out dough to 1/2 inch thickness.
- Cut with cookie cutter.
- Place 1 inch apart on cookie sheets.
- Bake for 35 to 45 minutes or until golden brown.
- Cool completely.
- Store loosely covered.

Garlic and Chicken Treats

Ingredients

- 2 cups whole-wheat flour
- 2 cups regular flour
- 2 cups white cornmeal
- 6 tbsp olive oil
- 3 eggs (beaten)
- 1 cup juice from boiling chicken breasts
- 8 fresh garlic cloves
- 2 pounds chicken breast

Recipe

- Place olive oil, fresh eggs, chicken stock, fresh peeled garlic cloves, and boiled chicken in a food processor.
- Process until little chunky.
- Then mix in the flours and cornmeal.
- Place on greased cookie sheets.
- Bake 20 minutes in a 450-degree oven.

Gourmet Dog Biscuits

Ingredients

- 2 pounds of raw chicken liver
- 3 cups of white flour
- 2 cups uncooked Oats
- 6 bouillon cubes, chicken
- 2 cups water
- 4 eggs, beaten

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 350F.



- Grease 3 baking sheets.
- Chop the liver finely, in a food processor.
- Mix flour and oats, crumble in the bouillon cubes.
- Add eggs and the chopped liver.
- Add enough water to make a firm but slightly sticky dough.
- Roll to 1/2 inch thick and use your favorite cookie cutter.
- Bake 1 hour.
- Store in an airtight container.
- These must be refrigerated.

Made Ahead Dog Snacks

These snacks are not only healthy but they can be made ahead of time and baked on an as needed basis.

Ingredients

- 3 1/2 cups plain flour
- 2 TBSP toasted wheat germ
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1/2- cup sesame seeds
- 1 1/2 sticks butter
- 1 cup ground walnuts
- 1 tsp vanilla extract

Recipe

- Mix all the ingredients.
- Knead until thoroughly blended.
- Divide into equal parts.
- Roll each into a log.
- Wrap in plastic wrap and freeze.
- Preheat oven to 375F and slice logs into appropriate sized pieces.
- Place cookies on a non-greased cookie pan.
- Bake about 12 minutes.

Peanut Buttery Bones

Ingredients

- 2 packages dry yeast
- 1 cup lukewarm water
- 2 cups mashed potatoes
- 2 cups milk
- 1/2 cup molasses
- 1 cup chicken stock
- 2 cups chunky peanut butter
- 2 cups whole-wheat flour
- 1cup rye flour
- 1cup rice flour
- 2 eggs
- 4 cups all-purpose white flour

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 325°
- In a large bowl, dissolve the yeast in water.
- In saucepan, mix together the potatoes, milk, molasses, stock, and peanut butter.
- Heat, stirring frequently until boiling.
- Remove from heat and let cool.
- Add yeast mixture.
- Gradually combine in the egg, wheat, rye, and rice flours. Add enough white flour to form stiff dough.
- Knead on a floured surface until smooth.
- Roll to 1/2" thick.
- Using cookie cutters cut out biscuits.
- Place on a non greasy baking sheets, spacing them about 1/4" apart.
- Bake for 45 minutes.
- Let cool overnight.

Peanut Butter Dog Biscuits

A very good source of nutrition as well as taste

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 cups water
- 1/2 cup oil
- 2 eggs
- 3 tablespoons peanut butter
- 2 tsp. vanilla
- 2 cups flour
- 1/2 cup cornmeal
- 1/2 cup oats

Recipe

- Blend wet ingredients together.
- Whisk dry ingredients together and mix into wet mixture to form a ball of dough.
- Roll out and shape.
- Put onto a non-stick cookie tray or lightly greased one.
- Cook 20 minutes at 400°.
- Turn off oven and allow the biscuits to cool in oven until crisp and hard.
- Store in airtight container.

Peanut Butter n' Honey

Honey is a favorite treat for dogs. Your dog will love it.

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup honey
- 2 cups crunchy peanut butter
- 4 cups chicken broth or water
- 2/3 cup peanut oil
- 1 cup rolled oats



- 2-cup oat bran
- 8 cups oat flour

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 350°
- In a saucepan, combine honey, peanut butter chicken broth, and peanut oil.
- Heat, stirring often, until mixture begins to simmer.
- Remove from heat.
- Mix in rolled oats and oat bran and let cool until lukewarm -- or cool enough to work with.
- Slowly blend in oat flour, adding enough to form stiff dough.
- Knead on a floured surface until smooth roll to 1/4" thick.
- Use cookie cutters or cut into small squares.
- Transfer to non greasy baking sheets, spacing them about 1/4" apart.
- Bake for 30 minutes, until golden brown on both sides.

Peanut Butter Puppy Poppers

Poppers puppies will love.

Ingredients

- 4 cups whole-wheat flour
- 2 tbsp. baking powder
- 2 cups peanut butter (chunky or smooth)
- 2 cups milk

Recipe

- Preheat oven to 375°.
- Take a bowl, combine flour and baking powder.
- In a separate bowl, mix peanut butter and milk, and then add to dry ingredients and combine well.
- Place dough on a lightly floured surface and knead.



- Roll dough to 1/4" thick.
- Cookie cutters to cut out shapes.
- Bake for 20 minutes on a greased baking sheet until lightly brown. Cool on a rack, then store in an airtight container.

Poochie Puffs

These are a new twist that all dogs will love to eat.

Ingredients

- 2 package Dry yeast
- 1/2 cup Warm water
- 3 cups Whole-wheat flour
- 2 cups All-Purpose flour
- 2 package unflavored gelatin
- 2 cups Non-fat dry milk powder
- 1/2 cup Corn oil
- 2 Eggs
- 2 cups wet food
- 1/2 cup Water

Recipe

- Dissolve yeast in 1/2 cup warm water.
- Combine dry ingredients.
- Add the rest ingredients together.
- Drop dough by rounded half-teaspoons onto non-greased cookie sheet.
- Bake in a preheated 300° oven for 25 minutes.

Puffy Doggy Drops

Puppies will love to play with this pasta as well as eat it!!!

Ingredients

- 6 cups whole-wheat flour
- 2 pounds beef liver
- 6 whole eggs
- 2 tablespoons olive oil

Recipe

- Puree beef liver in food processor until smooth.
- Add eggs and blend for about a minute.
- Put flour in a large mixing bowl and make a well in the center of the flour.
- Combine wet ingredients in bowl.
- Knead on a floured surface for at least 5 minutes or until smooth and shiny.
- Wrap dough in plastic wrap and let dough rest in refrigerator for at least 1 hour.
- When ready to make pasta, divide dough into 8 equal portions. Form into desired pasta shapes with hands or use pasta machine.
- Cook in rapidly boiling water until al dente.
- For thin noodles, approximately 10 minutes, for thicker noodles a few minutes longer.
- Drain noodles as desired.

Yummy Doggy Drops

Your dog is real hungry. Why don't you serve him this fast cooked tasty treat?

Ingredients

- 2 pkg. dries yeast
- 1/2 cup warm water (110-115F.)
- 3 cups whole-wheat flour
- 2 cups flour
- 2 pkg. unflavored gelatin



- 2 cups dry milk powder
- 1/2 cup corn oil
- 2 eggs
- 3 cups wet food
- 1/2 cup water

Recipe

- Dissolve yeast in 1/2 cup warm water.
- Mix all dry ingredients together.
- Drop dough by level half-teaspoons onto non-greased cookie sheet.
- Bake in a preheated 300° oven for 25 minutes.
- Leave in oven to dry and cool.
- Store in an airtight container.

Puppy Pretzels

Dogs will love to gnaw on these!!! Dried Liver powder and bone meal flour can be found in pet stores.

Ingredients

- 2 teaspoon brown sugar
- 4 teaspoons active dry yeast
- 1-1/3 cup water
- 1 1/2 cup whole-wheat flour
- 6 tablespoons soy flour, low fat
- 1/2 cup nonfat dry milk
- 2tablespoon dried liver powder
- 2-tablespoon bone meal flour
- 1 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 eggs
- 4 tablespoons cooking oil
- 6 tablespoons wheat germ
- Dissolve yeast and sugar in warm water.



Recipe

- Combine dry ingredients.
- Add half of the beaten egg, oil and yeast-water mixture.
- Stir well.
- Knead on a well-floured board until dough is firm.
- Turn in oiled bowl to cover all of the dough, cover and let rise until double in bulk.
- Shape into pretzels and place on greased cookie sheet.
- Bake in preheated 375° oven for 15 minutes.
- Remove and brush with beaten egg and sprinkle with wheat germ. Return to oven and bake at 300° for about 15 minutes until nicely browned and quite firm.

- 3 cups water

- Preheat oven to 350°
- Mix all dry ingredients in a large mixing bowl.
- Mix egg and corn oil in a small bowl.
- Stir water into dry ingredients, then add egg mixture, mix well. Batter should be thin
- Divide batter between baking sheets spreading to 1/2" thick
- Bake 45 minutes
- Let cool, then break into small pieces
- Store in tight container in refrigerator or divide into individual servings and place into freezer bags and freeze.
